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### Into the Bible....

⇒ Thank God for His Word! He will always address and answer every situation in our lives! Pastor Mirek is teaching out of the passage **2 Corinthians 4:6-18**. It would be good for someone to read the whole passage aloud. (or take one scripture each)

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⇒ Paul was no stranger to adversity. Read **verse 8 and 9** again. The reason we can overcome is **verse 6**. In the midst of dark times, how do we depend on the light that is in us?

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⇒ **Verse 7** says that *“we have this treasure in earthen vessels”*. The very light and power of God resides in our mortal bodies! This reminds us of Gideon’s army. Read **Judges 7:16**. We are those clay pots, and the light and power of God is in us. How do we brake the pitchers and release that light? Go back to our text and read **verse 13**. What does it say is the spirit of faith?

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⇒ **Romans 10:8** says, *“But what does faith say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach.)* To close, discuss how each on of us can put to work this spirit of faith, both in our personal lives this week and for the end of this global crisis.

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
