Into the Bible....

⇒ Pastor Mirek’s message this week is “Living on Purpose”. **Proverbs 19:21** in the Passions states “A person may have many ideas concerning God’s plan for his life, but only the designs of His purpose will succeed in the end.” Of all of the skills that you have, which ones do you feel are God-given to serve the Body of Christ?

What ways can you become better skilled and trained to serve His purpose?
