- Pastor Mirek is continuing his teaching on the importance of the Word of God. What is the one thing that stood out to you the most in the sermon this week?

Into the Bible....

- Please read the main text this week , **John 10:34-36**. Jesus makes an amazing statement in the middle of this discourse. He said “and the Scripture cannot be broken”. Think of things that cannot be broken, and compare them to the Word of God. Ie: a granite stone, a steel beam, etc.

- Just as it takes many names to describe God, it takes many descriptions to take in the immensity of the Word of God. Read each of these references aloud and discuss what the Bible calls itself. **Romans 10:8 , 2 Timothy 2:15, Philippians 2:16, Ephesians 6:17, Romans 3:2**. How can these scriptures elevate how you view the Word of God in your life?

- Finish by reading **1 John 2:4-5**. We cannot say that we know God and not elevate and do His Word. The scripture says that if we do that, we are liars! Discuss how our attitude toward the Word of God is the same attitude we have of God Himself.
